2. Requirements

You must be running BlackBerry OS 4.0 or higher.

3. Installation

Please visit our website at www.javatekmedia.com to obtain the latest version of this software.

3.1. Install wirelessly using the Internet

Open the Internet Browser on your BlackBerry.

Go to <http://javatekmedia.com/downloads/cardpackgold.jad>

Click download.

3.2. Install using the Desktop Manager

Unzip this file to a directory on your computer: You can download it here if you don't have it:

Place your BlackBerry in the cradle or connect directly using your cable.

On your computer, open the Desktop Manager.

(This is usually located in the Start button under "Programs" → "BlackBerry" → "Desktop Manager")

Make sure that the Desktop Manager says "Connected" in the title bar.

Click on the "Application Loader" icon.

Select Add and follow the prompts.

4. Save Game

All games are automatically saved when exiting. Just select Resume from the menu to continue the last game played.

5. Poker

5.1. Objective

Get one of the poker hands listed below.

5.2. Game Play

After placing a bet, five cards will be dealt. Select the cards you wish to keep and select Draw. If you win, you can play again or Double Up.

Doubling Up gives you the opportunity to double your winnings. Five cards are dealt again with the first card facing up. To win you need to select a card that will be higher than the current one. If you tie, you can try again. If you lose, you forfeit all of your winnings from the turn. You may keep doubling up until you lose or continue, keeping your winnings.

5.3. Payoff

Royal Flush	300:1
Straight Flush	50:1
4 of a Kind	25:1
Full House	9:1
Flush	6:1
Straight	4:1
3 of a Kind	3:1
2 Pairs	2:1
Pair (Jack or higher)	1:1

5.4. Other

A pair only counts if it is Jack or higher.

6. Blackjack

6.1. Objective

Get a hand value that is closer to 21 than that of the dealer, without going over 21.

6.2. Game Play

After placing a bet, two cards will be dealt to yourself and the dealer. You then have the following options:

- Hit: draw another card.
- Stand: finish your turn and allow the dealer to play.

- Double Down: double the bet for the first two cards and draw only one additional card.
- Split: this is available if the first two cards dealt are a pair. Any combination of 10 and face cards are considered a pair. Both cards will split into separate hands that are now played independently. The amount you bet previously is added to the second hand. Splitting on aces allow you to receive only one additional card. An ace and 10 will now count as 21 instead of blackjack.

6.3. Payoff

Blackjack	3:1
Win	2:1
Draw	1:1

6.4. Other

Face cards count as 10 and an ace counts as 1 or 11.

7. Solitaire

7.1. Objective

Move all four aces to the top right empty piles, and build them up using the same suit from ace to king.

7.2. Game Play

Select the deck of cards on the top left corner in order to turn a card face-up. This card is now part of the discard pile. The seven piles below are the tableau, which can only hold a sequence from high to low cards with alternating colors. If an empty space appears on the tableau, it can only be filled by a king. Keep moving cards around, trying to fill up the piles with the aces in the top right corner. If these piles get filled completely, you have won the game. Otherwise, the game ends when you decide there are no more moves you can make.

7.3. Options

7.3.1. Draw Cards

To make this game harder, you can choose to turn over three cards at a time rather than just one.

7.3.2. Game Types

7.3.2.1 None

This is the standard game play where you play until you win or lose.

7.3.2.2 Scoring

Try and get as many points as possible using the following point system:

10 points	Move a card to a suit stack (Top right corner)
5 points	Move a card from the deck to the tableau
5 points	Turn over a card in the tableau
-15 points	Move a card from a suit stack back to the tableau
-20 points	For 3 card draw, lose points every time you go through the deck after the third time
-100 points	For 1 card draw, lose points every time you go through the deck after the first time

7.3.2.3 Timed

This will time how long it takes you to win the game. The timer will pause during phone calls or when switching to a different application.

8. Red Dog

8.1. Objective

Predict that the value of the middle card will be in between the two cards on the outside.

8.2. Game Play

After placing a bet, two cards are dealt to the player. If the two cards are:

- Adjacent: the player loses.
- Identical: the player cannot raise and wins only if the middle card is identical to the first two.
- Not identical: the player can raise. If the middle card is between the first two, the player wins.

8.3. Payoff

Three of a Kind	12:1
One Card Spread	6:1
Two Card Spread	5:1
Three Card Spread	3:1
Four and Up Card Spread	2:1

8.4. Other

Ace is high in this game.

Player can only raise up to the starting bet.

9. HiLo

9.1. Objective

Predict whether the next card will be higher or lower than the previous one.

9.2. Game Play

After placing a bet, a card will be turned over. Guess whether the following card will be higher or lower. If you guess correctly or the card is of equal value, you win the round and must try again with the following card. If you guess correctly for all the cards, you win.

9.3. Other

Ace is low in this game.

10. Options

10.1. Colors

Change the felt color and the card background color.

10.2. Font Sizes

The default starting font is small. Here you can choose a medium or large font.

10.3. Animation

When turned on, the cards in Blackjack and Poker get displayed one at a time.

10.4. High Scores

View your high scores for all the games. You can also reset the scores.

12. Troubleshooting

1. **You receive the following error message when installing the program: “The following modules could not be loaded because their digital signatures were invalid.”**

This is caused when attempting to install a third party application on a BlackBerry handheld that contains an IT Policy restricting the installation of third party applications. To resolve this you must contact your BlackBerry Enterprise Server administrator to modify the IT Policy, removing the restriction from installing third party applications.

2. **When you try loading any software using the BlackBerry Desktop Manager, you receive the following error: "No additional applications designed for your handheld were found."**

This occurs if you have the Desktop Manager software installed but are missing the Handheld Software (ie: your BlackBerry's operating system). Both need to be installed before any software can be added to your BlackBerry. You can find the Handheld software on your carrier's website.
